

Report from St Edmunds PCC - 13.11 2018 - 8 residents - Judy Tyler

Housing.....Sheltered Housing for over 55's, social but mainly a variety of large and small. Allow for shared ownership to enable young people to get a home.

Transport.....The Church needs parking. Garages are too small. Difficulty of parking at shops. Need safe walking between Taverham and Ringland, Taverham and Costessey. They enjoy the new path to Drayton Drewray. Footpath improvement on Fir Covert Road needed from roundabout to Garden Centre. Considerable difficulty getting onto Fakenham Road.

Environment.....There should be a vision to create 'centres' as lack of these contributes to people's isolation.

Important views are Breck Farm Road, Taverham Road Looking over the valley, towards Ringland and Thorpe Marriott Green(once the trees are pruned)

As Taverham sprawls it becomes more suburban,

Business.....The population of Taverham tends towards most people being under the age of 54 years. Younger people should be asked for their priorities. Safety is an important aspect for where young people can meet, as it is not as safe as it was.
